Fact Sheet

What is the Tipton Children's Home?	Tipton is long-term residential group home for children. Tipton is a safe alternative to state-run foster programs for children whose parents can no longer take care of them.
What is Tipton's mission?	Tipton's mission is to raise these children in a loving, stable, Christian environment and prepare them for adulthood.
Do the children have to go to church?	Youth attend regular church services and church related activities at the Tipton Church of Christ.
What ages are the children in this home?	The Tipton Children's Home is designed for children ages 5-17.
Do Tipton children go to school?	Tipton kids attend Tipton Public Schools and have access to tutoring and educational support from the house parents and staff.
Do Tipton children have extracurricular activity options?	The children are able to participate in Tipton school activities including: athletics, student council, drama, newspaper, yearbook, FFA, and academic teams.
Do the children have access to medical support?	Yes. Tipton has a team of therapists, psychologists, psychiatrists and mental health counselors in order to provide help for any emotional and behavioral difficulties these children may face.
Does it cost money to put a child in Tipton?	It does not cost the legal guardian to place a child in Tipton, but we do accept donations and volunteers.
